## Joint Health & Safety Committee training

Certification of JHSC members is required under the Occupational Health and Safety Act. Who must be certified is outlined in the legislation. If you are taking this course then you are about to begin the process of becoming a JHSC Certified Member for your workplace. Certification is made up of two parts: Part I covers five training modules and you must pass the test to move on to Certification Part II training. Part II will train participants on how to Recognize, Assess, and Control Hazards. The hazards have been assessed by your employer as significant, and most likely to cause illness or injury in your workplace. Once the training has been completed a form will be submitted to WSIB, they will send you a card that confirms your Certification.
